Last week, the blog covered *Craiyon*. The images were produced in version 2 of the application. This weekend, I generated abstract images using both *Craiyon* and *Dall-E-2*. In terms of abstract images, in my opinion, *Craiyon* now produces the superior images. Where *Dall-E-2*'s images are generated using bright, bold, loud colors, *Craiyon* does better in terms of nuances ranging from loud to quiet colors, forms, and shapes.

When seeking to generate abstract images, one should be sure to use “abstract” or “abstract painting” in the request.
